Dr. Flack is a Specialist in Clinical Hypertension and is Principal Investigator of the Center for Urban and African American Health at Wayne State University. Dr. Flack is also Specialist in Chief for Internal Medicine at the Detroit Medical Center.

Dr. Flack received a B.S. in Chemistry from Langston University (1978) and the MD degree from the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (OUHSC) (1982). He completed an Internal Medicine residency and served as Chief Medicine Resident at OUHSC (1982-86). Dr. Flack received an MPH in Epidemiology and completed an NIH fellowship in cardiovascular epidemiology at the University of Minnesota (1990).

Dr. Flack has over 135 peer-reviewed publications to his credit; he has been repeatedly named one of the “Best Doctors in America.” He received the Pillar of Excellence award from the Michigan Peer Review Organization (MPRO) and the Health Care Hero award from Crain’s Detroit Business (2005) for disparities-related research. He serves on the boards of MPRO, AHA-Metro Detroit, and the NKF Scientific Advisory Group. Dr. Flack is also a member of the Cardio-renal Advisory Panel for the Food and Drug Administration.
